### Equine Affaire, Springfield, MA November 13-16, 2008

**Breed Stall and Demo:** Gene and Vicky McCaffrey, Janet Cohen and Joyce and Dan Cornelius rotated horses in the breed stall throughout the show. As usual, the crowds around the stall to see the Shires were large.

The breed demo was in front of full stands and went very well, according to participants and spectators. Shires were shown in hand, ridden and driven. In addition to the McCaffrey's, Janet Cohen and Joyce and Dan Cornelius, Ayrshire Farm (Paul Tyrell) showed a pair hitched to a brewery dray. A second, shorter breed demo was held the same day in the youth pavilion. We hope to have some pictures available in the future.

Shires were also represented in the Fantasia performances all three evening in a presentation entitled 'Flying Feathers'. Janet Cohen drove Glenmary Hudson in a cart, Paul Tyrrell drove a unicorn of gray Ayrshire Shires to a restored roof seat break and a team of Freisans combined to make an excellent driving performance.

**ASHA Booth:** Despite rain for much of the show, attendance was good. A large number of brochures and magazines were given out and numerous questions about Shires answered. Information on Shires was also given out to several children and teachers for their equine studies classes or pony club projects. Vicky signed up two new memberships at the show and others who expressed some interest in joining were directed to the website.

<u>Merchandise Sales</u>: Sales income was slightly better than last year at \$2,169.10. Profits from these sales, combined with breed stall fees paid by participants, exceeded expenses this year. Therefore, with time and travel expenses donated by members, there was \$187.48 profit for this show.

Additionally, her valuable help with ideas for arranging the booth and displaying merchandise were significant in improving sales. # WOULD YOU LIKE TO RECEIVE YOUR BULLETIN BY E-MAIL?

Due to continuing problems with USPS bulk mail delivery, the board voted at the teleconference on July 12th to begin routinely sending the quarterly members' bulletin by first class mail and to look into E-mail delivery of the bulletin (and possibly additional information in the future) for those who would prefer the electronic method. According to the Association by laws, in order to set up electronic delivery of information from the association to the members, members must request this method of communication.

If you would prefer to receive your quarterly bulletin elec-tronically, send an E-mail to Karla Stoner at bloomforge@ peoplepc.com requesting this option. Once we have names of those who would prefer the electronic method, an address list will be set up and mailings will be initiated. The main advantage of this method will be quicker delivery of the bulletin. Members requesting electronic delivery will have to maintain current E-mail addresses with the Association to insure continued delivery.

Members preferring to receive their bulletins through the regular mail will continue to do so.

NOTE: this is for the members' bulletin only, not the magazine.

### PROBLEM RESOLUTION GUIDELINES

Do you have a problem with the Association? If so, here are the guidelines to be followed for resolving the problem.

- 1. Ask yourself if it is an Association problem. If so, talk directly to the party with whom you have a problem e.g., committee member, secretary, board member, President, etc.
- 2. If you do not get satisfaction, put your complaint in writing to the party concerned. (Verify delivery.) The party receiving the complaint should respond to you in writing within 14 days of receipt.
- 3. If you are not satisfied with this response, submit a written complaint to a board member of your choosing in a timely manner. (Verify delivery.) The board member shall notify the President (or Vice President if the complaint involves the President) that he/she is working on a problem. The board member shall interview all parties concerned in an attempt to mediate the dispute and then give each party involved a written recommendation in a timely manner.
- 4. If you are not satisfied after step 3, submit a written complaint to be addressed by the full Board. The Board decision will be final and so recorded.
